### TECHNICAL AIDS FOR DETECTION OF DECEPTION

---

**Purpose:** To establish policy concerning the use of technical aids for the detection of deception in criminal investigations.

**Policy Statement:** It is the policy of the North Little Rock Police Department to utilize technical aids for the detection of deception when necessary.

**Summary of Changes:** Section 1.3 changed to reflect polygraph exams to be given by trained member of the department. Added section 1.4 to provide guideline for use of polygraph examiner from outside department. New Format.

**Procedure:**

**1 Use of Technical Deception Aids [CALEA 42.2.6]**

- 1.1 The use of technical deception aids is not a common practice of the Investigations Division; however, during the course of an investigation, it may be essential to use equipment of a technical nature in the detection of deception.
- 1.2 When deemed necessary by the investigator, a polygraph examination will be administered strictly on a voluntary basis with the approval of an Investigations Division Lieutenant.
- 1.3 Polygraph examinations will be administered only by a member of the department who is a trained and licensed examiner.
- 1.4 In the event the department member is unavailable, polygraph exams may be administered using any licensed examiner with the approval of the Investigations Division Captain.
