Updated Information

North Little Rock, Arkansas (August 31, 2020) – In the evening hours of August 31, 2020, Detectives located the suspect vehicle. The vehicle will be processed for any evidence related to this incident.

Detectives are currently speaking with several people involved in this incident.

This investigation is active and ongoing.

Disturbance at Mall Leads to Shooting – Injuring One Person

North Little Rock, Arkansas (August 31, 2020) – At approximately 4:19 pm, the NLRPD received a call of shots fired with injury at the McCain Mall. Officers immediately responded and found one adult male inside the Robert Irwin Jewelry Store suffering from at least one gunshot wound to his body. Officers rendered medical aid to the victim until medical professionals arrived on scene.

Once MEMS arrived, they transported the victim to a local hospital for further treatment. His condition is unknown at this time.

The preliminary investigation into the shooting by Officers revealed that a physical disturbance occurred just in front of the jewelry store. During the disturbance, at least one suspect produced a firearm and shot at the victim at least one time. Officers were able to gather a suspect vehicle description. The suspect vehicle is a 2012 White Honda Civic bearing Arkansas License Plate 785 UGI.

Detectives responded to the mall and processed it for evidence. Detectives are also interviewing multiple witnesses at the NLRPD Investigations Division.

This incident is believed to be isolated with no threat to the general community. The investigation is in its early stages, active and ongoing.
