North Little Rock Police Release Information Regarding Person of Interest in Mid-Day Bank Robbery

North Little Rock, AR (July 12, 2022)—North Little Rock Police have identified a person of interest in a mid-day bank robbery that occurred at the Bank of America located at 200 Main Street.

Detectives with the North Little Rock Police are wanting to speak with Ombleo John Daniels in reference to his possible involvement in the incident.

North Little Rock Police Investigating Attempted Bank Robbery

North Little Rock, AR (July 12, 2022) — On July 12, 2022, at approximately 12:16 p.m. Officers with the North Little Rock Police Department responded to 200 Main Street (Bank of America) in reference to a robbery in progress.

Upon arrival, officers secured the location and began searching the surrounding area for the suspect who left the location on foot. The suspect was described as an adult white male wearing a black shirt. Preliminary information indicates that the suspect did not take anything from the bank. At this time, the suspect has not been apprehended.

Detectives with the North Little Rock Police Department were contacted and have responded to initiate an investigation.

Detectives are currently processing the scene for evidence and conducting interviews.

There are no reported injuries associated with this incident.
